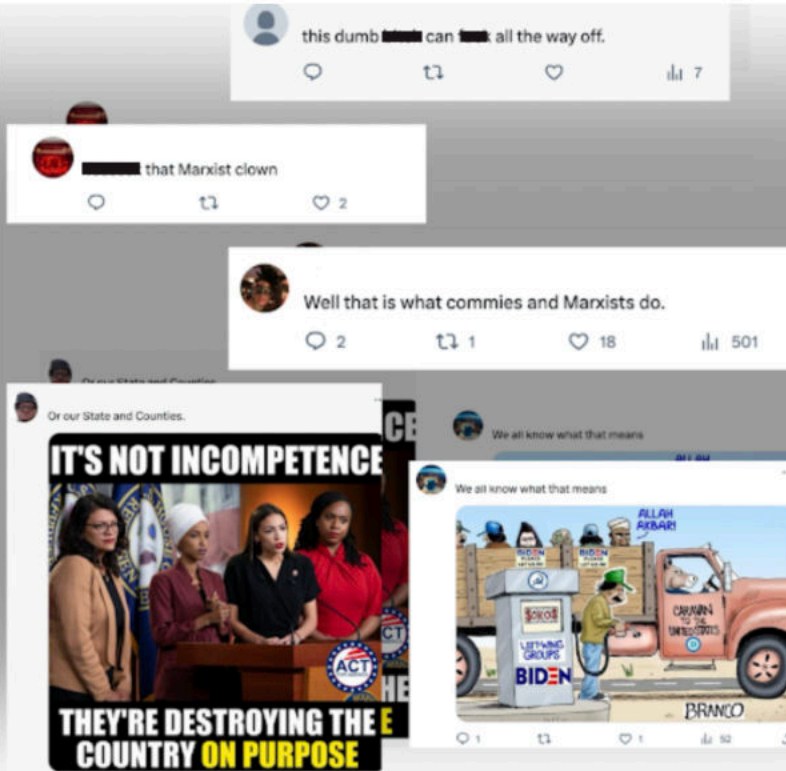




WASHINGTON STATE DEMOCRATS
